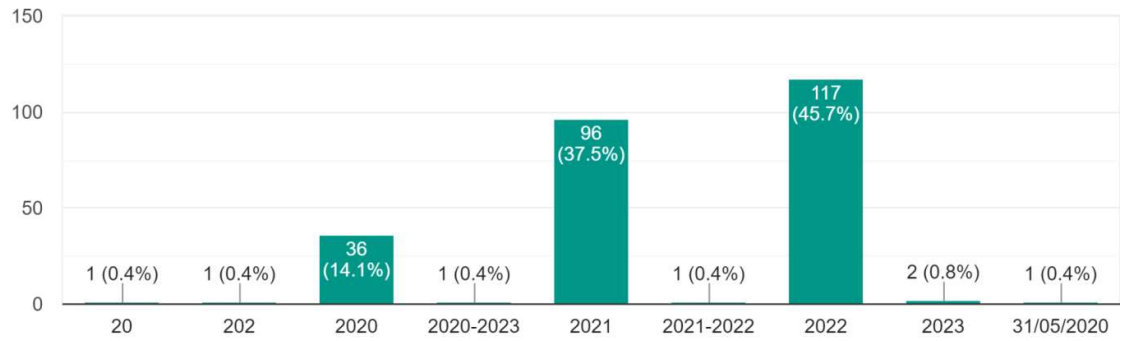

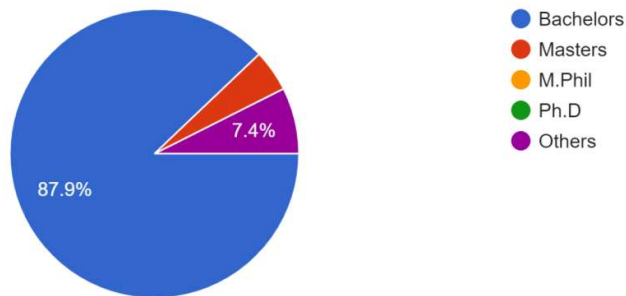

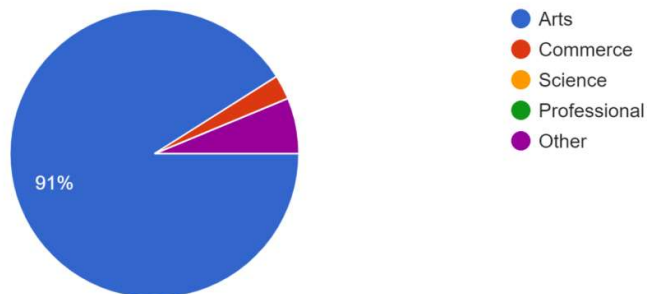
Which degree programmed are you pursuing now

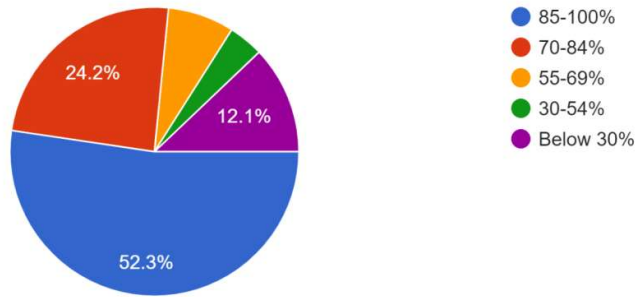

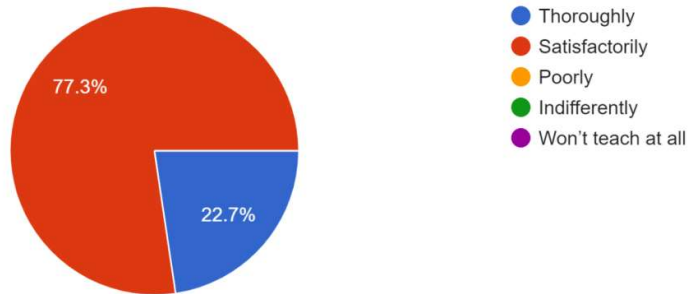
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class

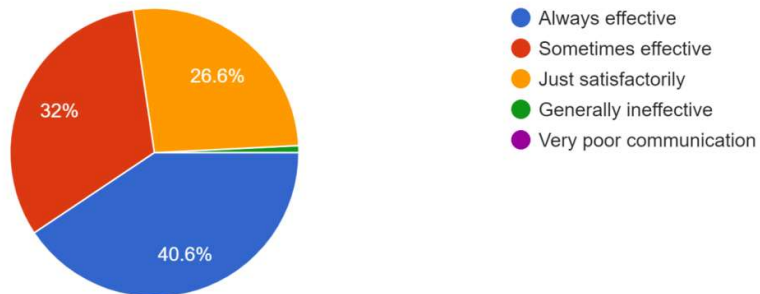

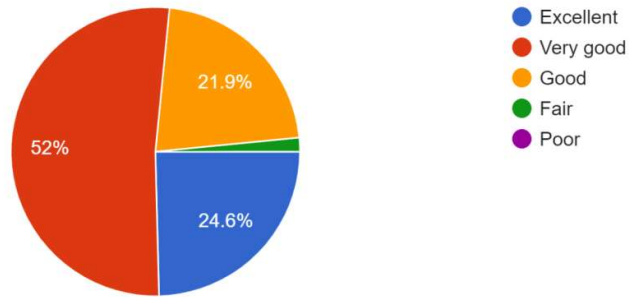

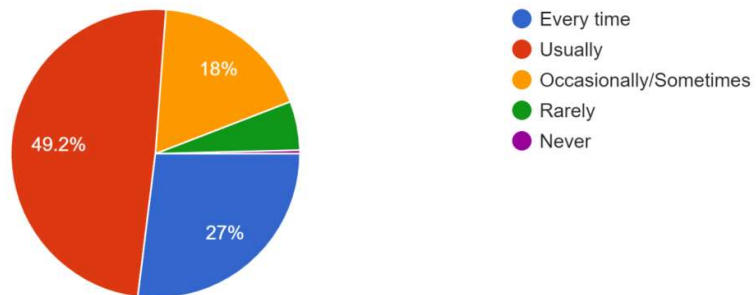
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

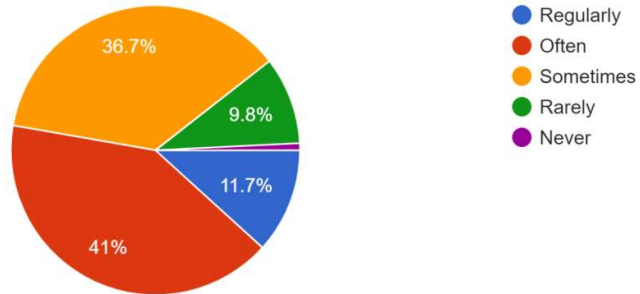

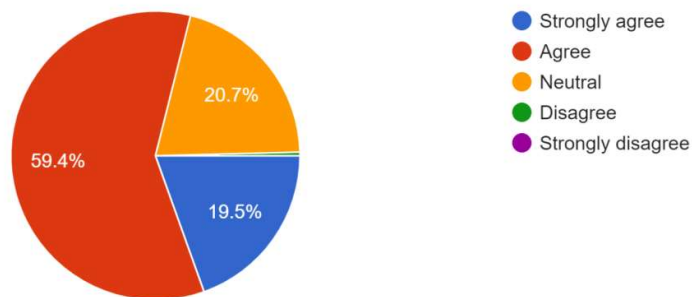

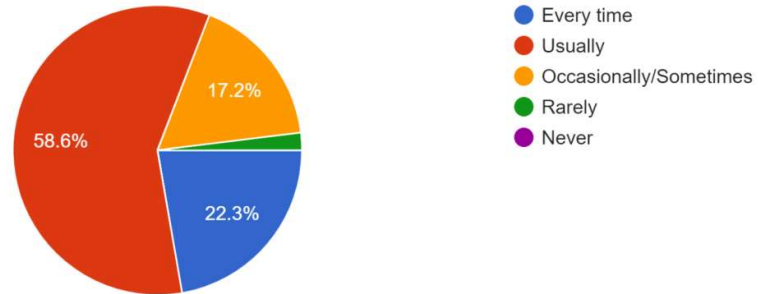

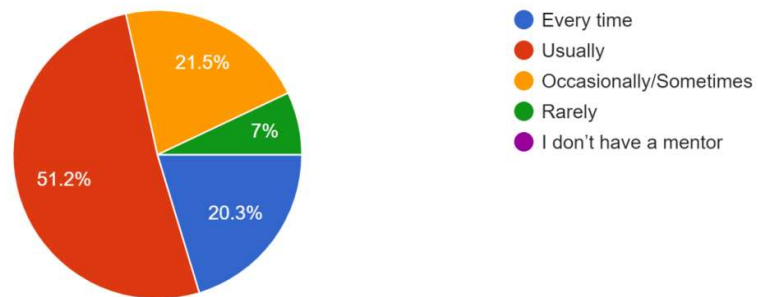

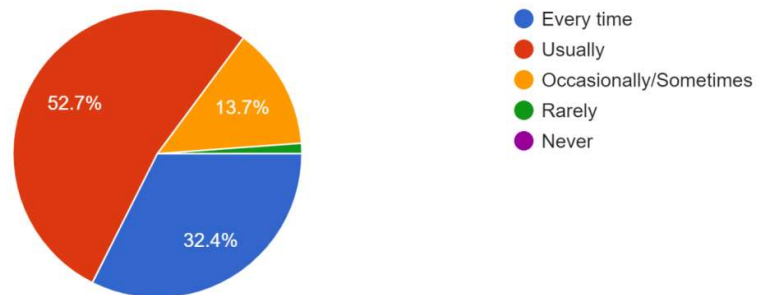

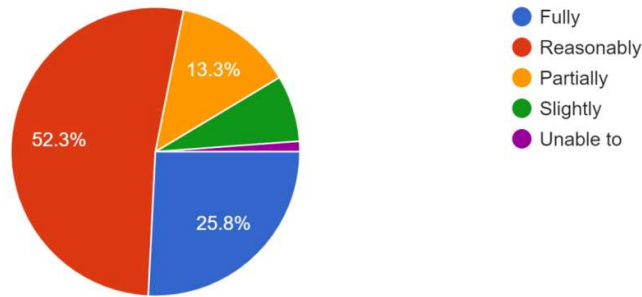

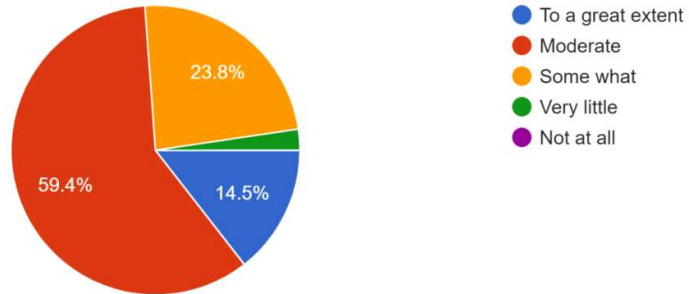

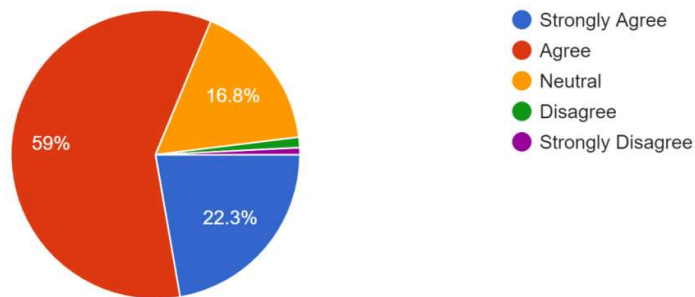

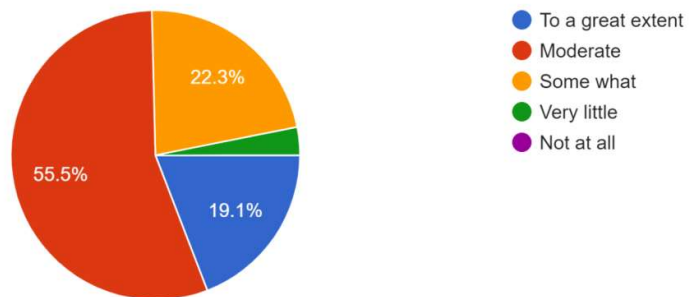

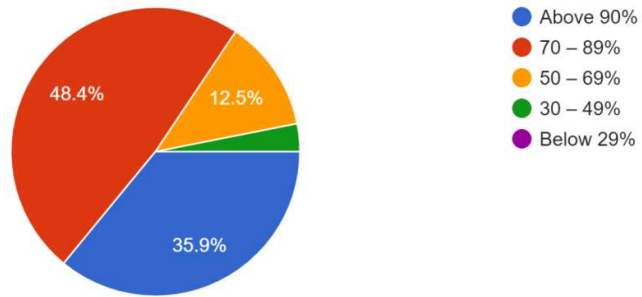
