




How do you rate the programme that your ward undergoing in terms of the load of the courses in different semesters?


Data Interpretation


How do you rate the availability of the text and reference books in the market?


How do you rate the treatment of the students by the faculty irrespective of the background of the student (Gender, cast, community, creed etc.) in teaching and evaluation?

How do you rate the programmes based on the comfort of your ward in coping with the workload?




Data Interpretation


How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum in providing employment opportunities?

How do you rate the transformation of your ward after the completion of the course?




Data Interpretation




How do you rate the fulfillment of the course according to your expectations?
