### AIMS & OBJECTIVES OF RRC:

- To harness the potential of the Youth by equipping them with correct information on HIV/AIDS Prevention, Care and Support and Treatment.
- To build their capacities as peer educators in spreading messages on positive health behaviour in an enabling environment
- To reduce new HIV infection among Youth by raising their risk perception through awareness on HIV/AIDS.
- To induce among Youth, the spirit to help and support People Living with HIV (PLHIV), thereby reducing stigma and discrimination against PLHIV.
- To motivate Youth and build their capacity as peer educators and change agents by developing their skills on leadership, negotiation, and team building.

#### REPORTING &FINANCE:

- In order to conduct RRC activities, a one-time grant of Rs.9000/- will be provided for the first year of RRC formation and thereafter a grant of Rs.4000/- annually or as allocated by National AIDS Control Organisation (NACO) on a yearly basis for effective implementation of the activities.
- Fund will be disbursed to the institution only after signing of MoU with NSACS.
- The fund granted will be utilized only for RRC activities.
- Reports along with photographs and Utilization Certificate / Statement of Expenditure (SOE) for conducting the activities should be submitted to NSACS, 15 days after completion of the activity or before 1st week of February. The Utilization Certificate / Statement of Expenditure can be prepared on the UC format available at NSACS office or on the Institution letterhead, duly signed and sealed by the Nodal Officer/ Programme Officer for RRC & the Principal.

On ground of non-performance or non-submission of report/SOE by the institution, NSACS reserves the right to withdraw funding for RRC at any point of time.
