MEMORUNDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Whereas the above-named organisations recognize that knowledge sharing collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would promote research by engaging themselves in collaborative academic activities.

This Agreement made on this 1st day of October, 2022 between Nagaland International Research Centre (NIRC) having its office at Kohima, Nagaland and Don Bosco College Kohima having its office at Kohima, Nagaland.

DESIROUS of strengthening cooperation between the two parties in research and academic exchanges;

DESIRING to exchange knowledge and experience and to strengthen bilateral academic cooperation;

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES declare their agreement as follows:

1. GENERAL PURPOSE OF THIS AGREEMENT

The parties to this Agreement have determined that it is in their respective organizations' interest to work together to create the best chance of developing and expanding academic collaboration on areas of mutual interest, and in order to reach this goal the Parties will carry out the following:

- (i) Organisation of seminars, workshops and courses of interest to both parties,
- (ii) Knowledge sharing
- (iii) Undertake joint research project
- (iv) Exchange programs for research scholars.
- (v) Other forms of cooperation as may be mutually agreed upon.
- (vi) Gender Sensitivity, Human Rights, Human Values and Environment & Sustainability
- (vii) Village Adoption, House to House Visit, Survey, Distribution of food & Clothes and other essential items during festival, Jail Visit, Orphanage Visit, Old age Home Visit and Awareness Programmes.

2. PROGRAM ELABORATION AND OTHER DIRECTIONS OF COLLABORATION

The purposes defined in Article 1 will be elaborated by special working plans, framed by the Parties. The Parties may determine other directions of collaboration, which will be formalized by signing a supplementary to the present MoU from time to time.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF THIS COLLABORATION

- (i) This collaboration will be based on the availability of appropriate participants and availability of funds for successful implementation.
- (ii) The program developed will be those in which both Parties agree to be the most useful with respect to meeting their respective objectives.
- (iii) The implementation of a program shall be negotiated and determined mutually by the two Parties.
- (iv) Each Party will cooperate, as best as possible, to help the other Party to define, plan and implement such programs as were determined to be of mutual interest.
- (v) In general, the cost of activities under this Agreement shall be borne by the first organising party and the supporting party will extend whatever help is required.
- (vi) There will be no common fund or revenue sharing between the two Parties as the collaboration will have no legal or financial implication on either of the Parties.

4. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

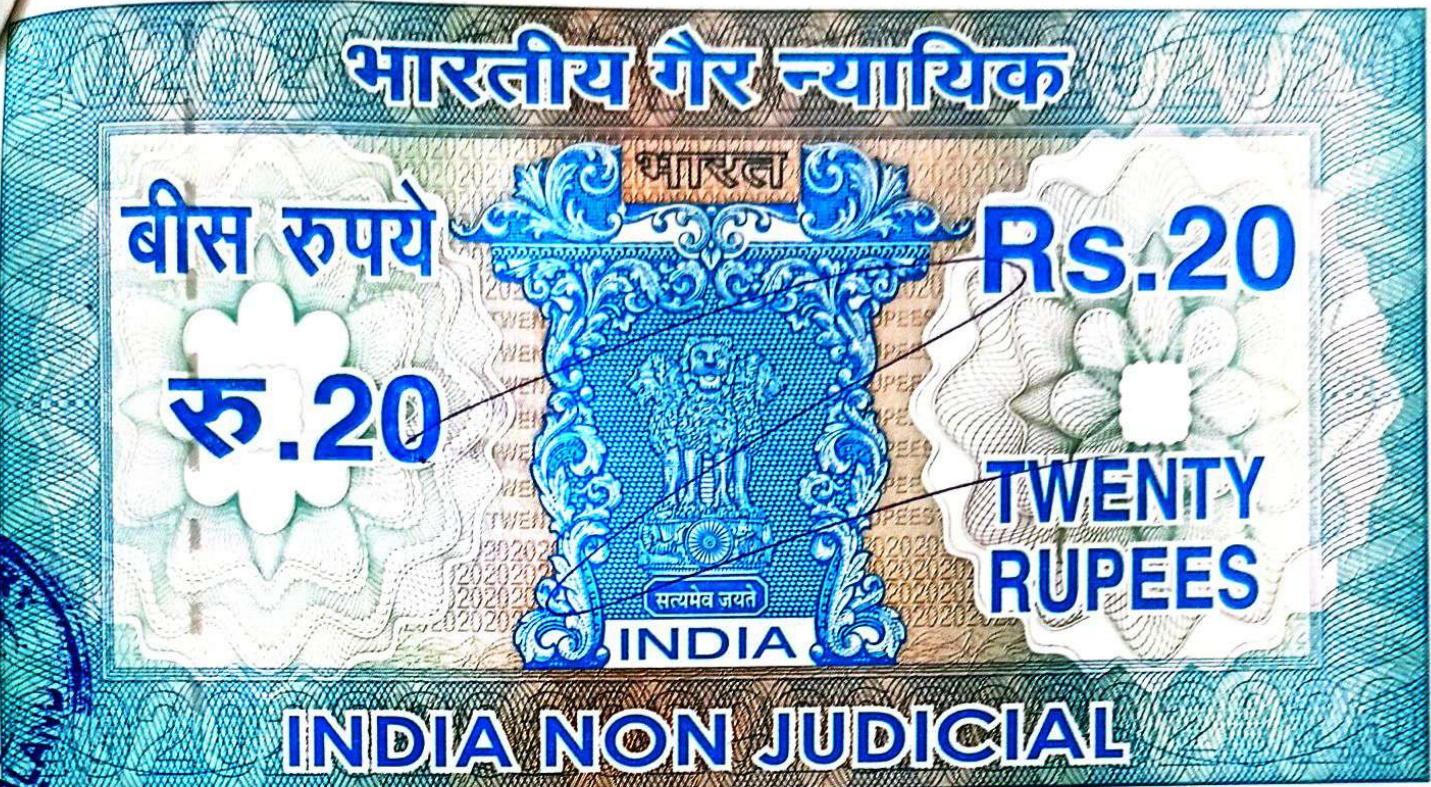
The Parties agree that English language will be used in all the working documents.


