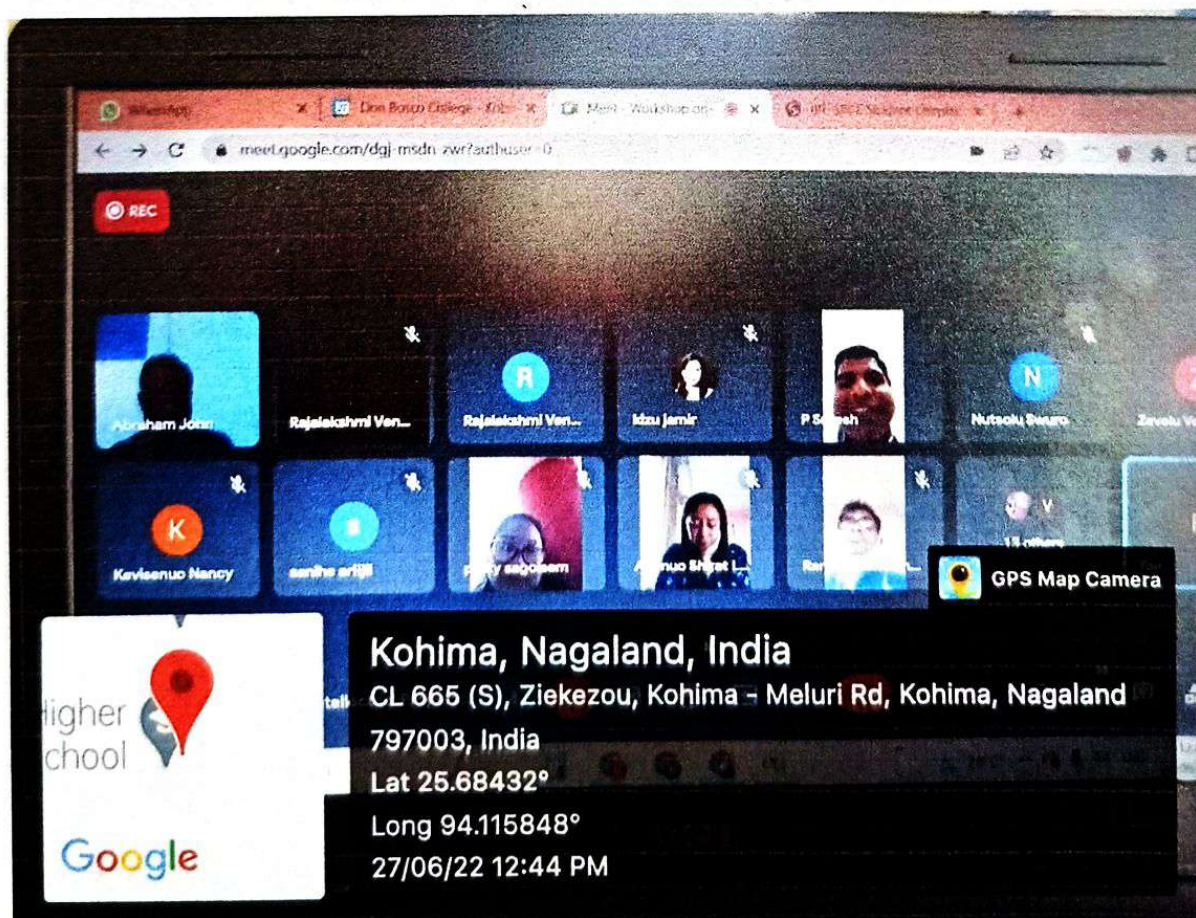

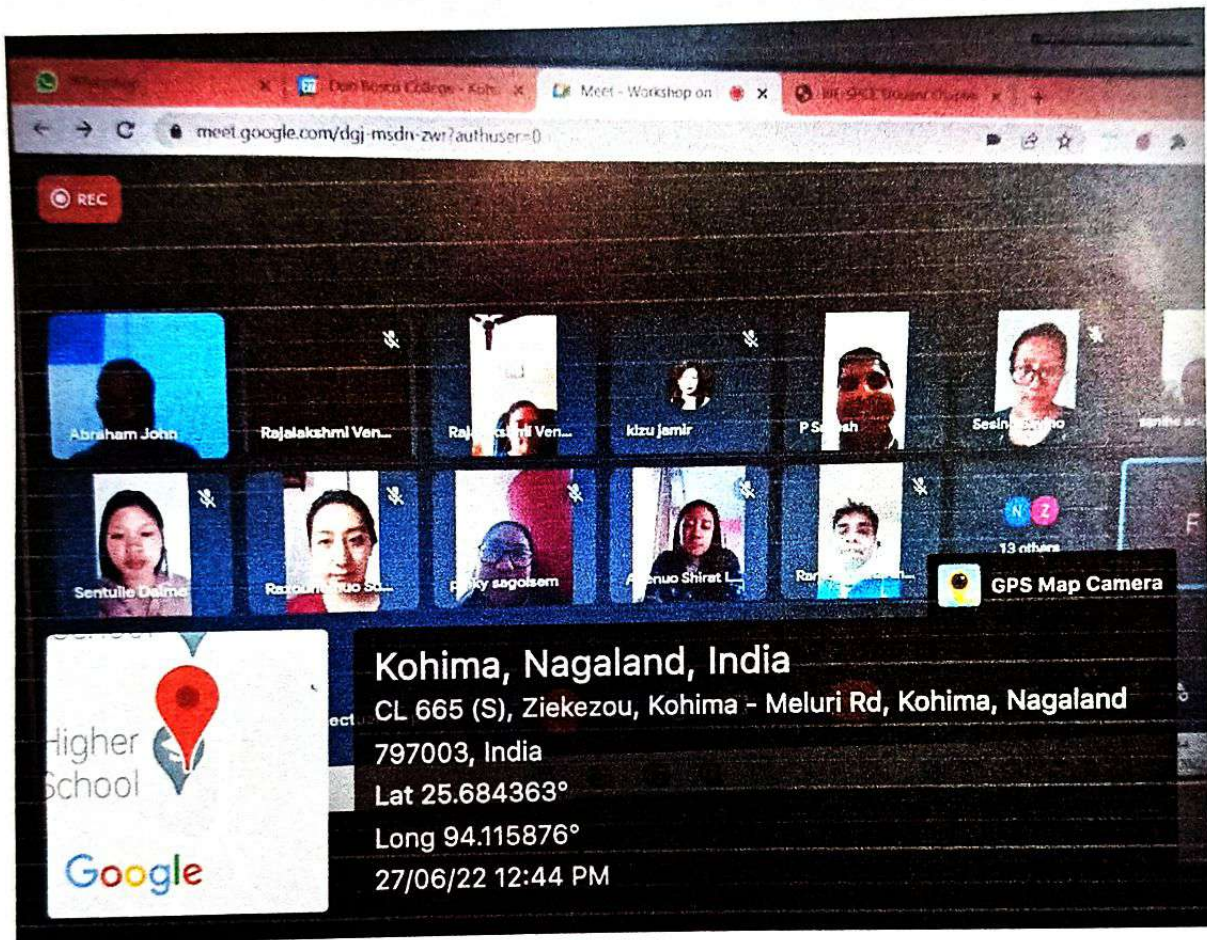

Venue for the workshop was at Capital Convention Centre, Near Secretariat Complex, Kohima. The objective was to create awareness about IPR among the people in the state, to provide free patent search and guidance to investors about patenting their inventions and to create IPR cells in universities and colleges. The programme started from 9:30 a.m till 5 p.m with tea and lunch break intervals between sessions. The inaugural session was chaired by Dr. Nesatalu Hiese (Scientist 'D' & programme Coordinator) with keynote address delivered by Dr. Yashwant Dev Panwar (Head, IPR Division, TIFAC, New Delhi). The technical session was chaired by Smti. Gihukali Chishi with the following resource person: Prof. S.K Jain (Former VC, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University; Former Head DMS, IIT Delhi), Dr. Indira Baneerjee (Attorney, PS Davar & Co.) and Dr. Yashwant Dev Panwar. ## Report on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Workshop

A one day workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) was held at Don Bosco College, Kohima on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2023 with Ms. Gihukali Chishi, Technical In-charge, PIC, NASTEC, Kohima, Nagaland as the resource person.

During the workshop, the resource person gave an overview of the Patent Information Center under Science & Technology, Government of India and activities undertaken by the establishment. The workshop made in-depth focus on the importance of IPR and its various forms. Highlighting the significance of IPR, the resource person outlined how IPR promotes innovation, which is much needed for economic growth at both the national and global levels.

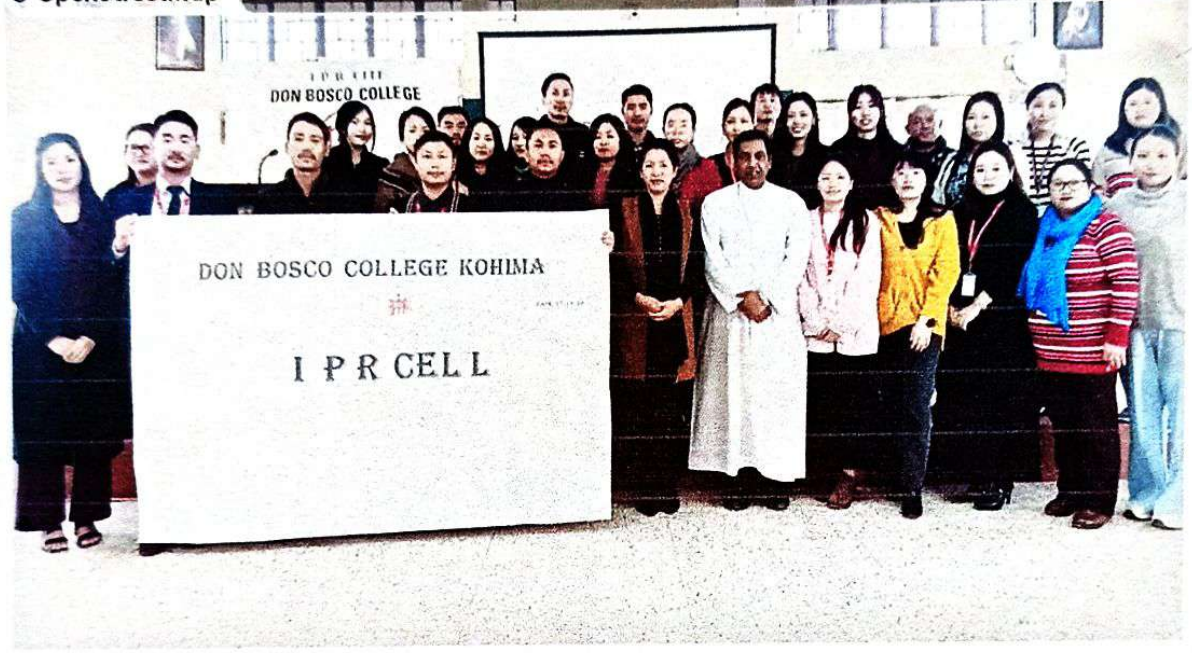
Copyrights, Trademarks, Industrial Design, Geographical Indication and Patenting were the several forms of IPR discussed in the workshop. While underlining the concepts, the resource person also detailed on the different types and instances of such forms. Elaborating on the concept of copyright infringement, and instancing 'fair use' of copyrights, she reminded the gathering to be cautious, especially as an educational institution while conducting scholarly works.

In discussing Integrated Circuits (IC), Plant Variety Protection and Farmers Rights, Trade secrets, Traditional Knowledge and Geographical Indication (GI) the resource person made comprehensive conceptualization and mentioned instances of various states, brands, etc. which greatly benefited the gathering with such common, but usually unwary of the terms and related lawsuit cases. Also making special mention of Nagaland, she stated that the state has so far four of its products with GI tags. Stressing further on the importance of GI, the resource person dwelled on the need for more of such awareness in the state and urged upon to be careful in showcasing local products/items especially traditional attire; and reminded that "it is a safe to get our properties protected".

Mention may be made that the one day long fruitful workshop was the first activity conducted under the newly established IPR Cell of DBCK. The programme was convened and chaired by Dr. Khikeya Semy, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, DBCK. Fr. Christudoss, Campus Minister DBCK invoked God's presence, while vote of thanks was proposed by Mr. Imtiwapang, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, DBCK. The workshop was attended by academic and administrative staffs of the college at DBCK Hall T1.
