
The activity started at 9:00 a.m. with attendance taking and going to the respective plot given to it. The departments had to strategize how to tackle the weeds, soften the soil for the next plantation, remove the old fences and replaceit with new ones, how and where to properly dispose of the waste, and to make footpaths stable for going up and down while working and taking care of the garden.

The first half of the work went smoothly with clearing out the boundaries first, to mark and indicate where to work under it, and sort out more in detail where workwas needed.

The second part of the work was more tedious and steeper, where the English dept. encountered a wasp's hive and got stung by it, making it a memorial day, in the end they were able to clear out both the weeds and the hive, which was two birds with one stone.

The students after the rough clearing the plot, more details in removing the remaining weeds came in next, where the soil was ploughed, the removal of the old unstabled fences, as more bamboos where placed and hammered down in places, making of footpaths for going up and down, where the work was done oneafter the other.

One by one each department left as the work was done in the end. The last remaining department was English and the work was done till 12:25am followedby geo tagged pictures, where the students cleaned up and ended the day with the refreshment provided by the college.







Report on Vermicomposting Certificate Course

Vermicompost Certificate Course was held on 20th January 2022 to 30th May 2022. There was both theory and practical class for the students. Some of the practical events and workshop were:

On 3rd March 2022, the 6th Semester students in collaboration with Bosco Green Allaince and department of Soil and Water Conservation Government of Nagaland. It was chaired by Ankita Priyadarshani, invocation by Hector, felicitation by Fr. Dr. P Suresh, talk by the resource person and vote of thanks by Micheal.


Mr. Ruokuosietuo Rokus Dist. Soil Conservation Officer Mokokchung was the resource person. He stressed on the importance of vermicomposting and how it helps in reducing environmental pollution. He also talked about the construction process, raw material for bedding, maintaining the moisture content and the right time for harvesting of the manures. And that the whole process takes about 2-3 months so we can produce sufficient amount of manures.

The Formal programme was followed by demonstration, where at the vermicomposting site he demonstrated about the filtering of the vermin from vermiwash and the vermicomposting bedding and structure.

And on 17th March 2022 As part of the practical class, Bosco Green Alliance conducted a field work in the veemicompost pit of the college on 17th March, 2022. The work was led by 6th semester students where 10 students were selected from each department along with Sir Sanihe Ariijii, Asst.Professor, coordinator of Bosco Green Alliance were present.

The activity included collecting dry grasses and plants which were moulded down by knife and then lay out for further drying in front of vermi compost pit to feed them after a week along with organic waste materials. After the preparation of vermicompost feed was done, filterering of the harvested vermi was carried out by few students.

The Certificate course ended on 30th May 2022 where the certificates were issued to the students by Mr. Sanihe Ariijii, Coordinator Bosco Green Alliance and Mr.Ruokucsietue Rocus, Dist. Soil Conservation Officer, Mokokchng Nagaland.
