AWARENESS PROGRAMME TO CHEDEMA

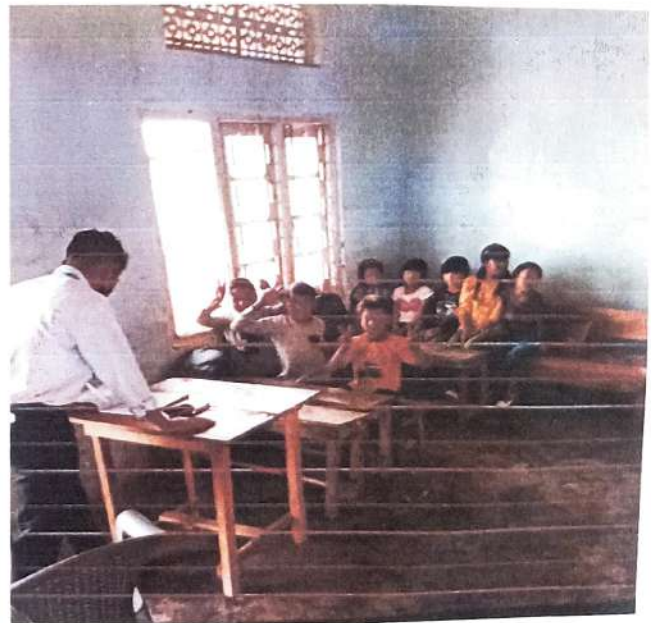
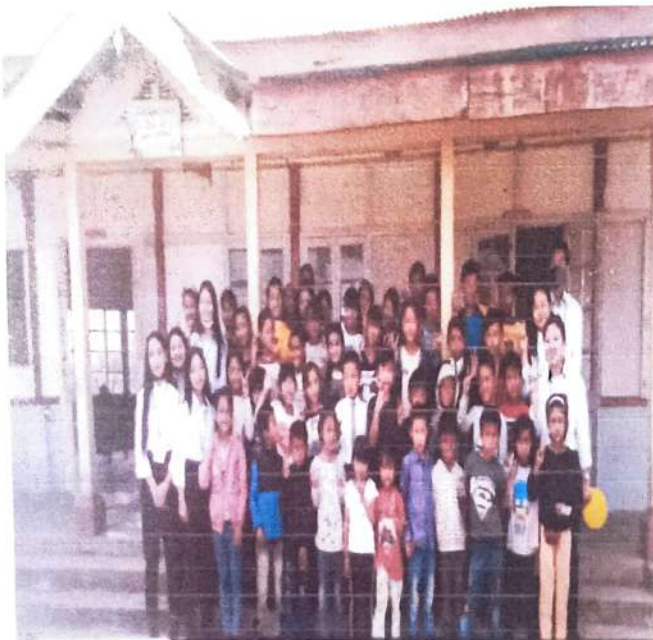
