## Report on trip to Ciephobozou

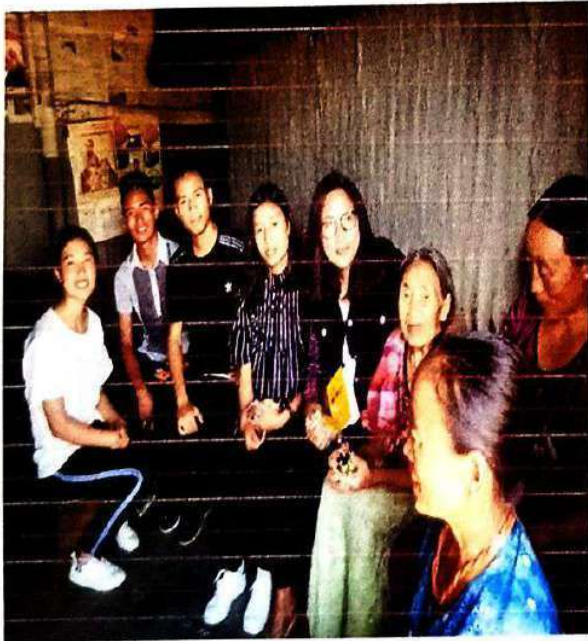

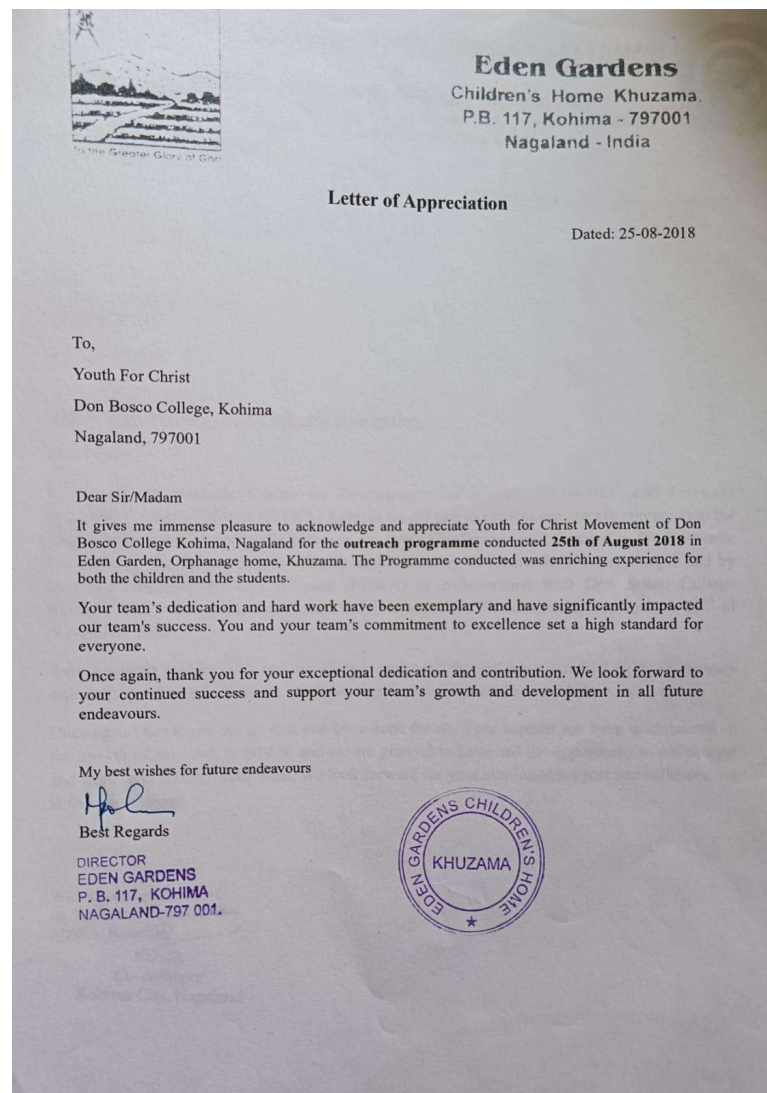
