



REPORT ON BASIC ENGLISH GRAMMAR RULES CERTIFICATE COURSE

The Department of English, Don Bosco College Kohima has offered a certificate course on Basic Grammar Rules for the 3rd Semester Students from 1st August-15th August, 2018. The initiative was taken with an objective to improvise and sharpen the grammatical foundation in the students. The course has covered on the Subject-Verb Agreement, Tense, Modals, Articles, Preposition and Conjunction rules. 153 students availed the course. During the course, one formative assessment test was conducted to monitor the student progress and provide feedback for improvement. 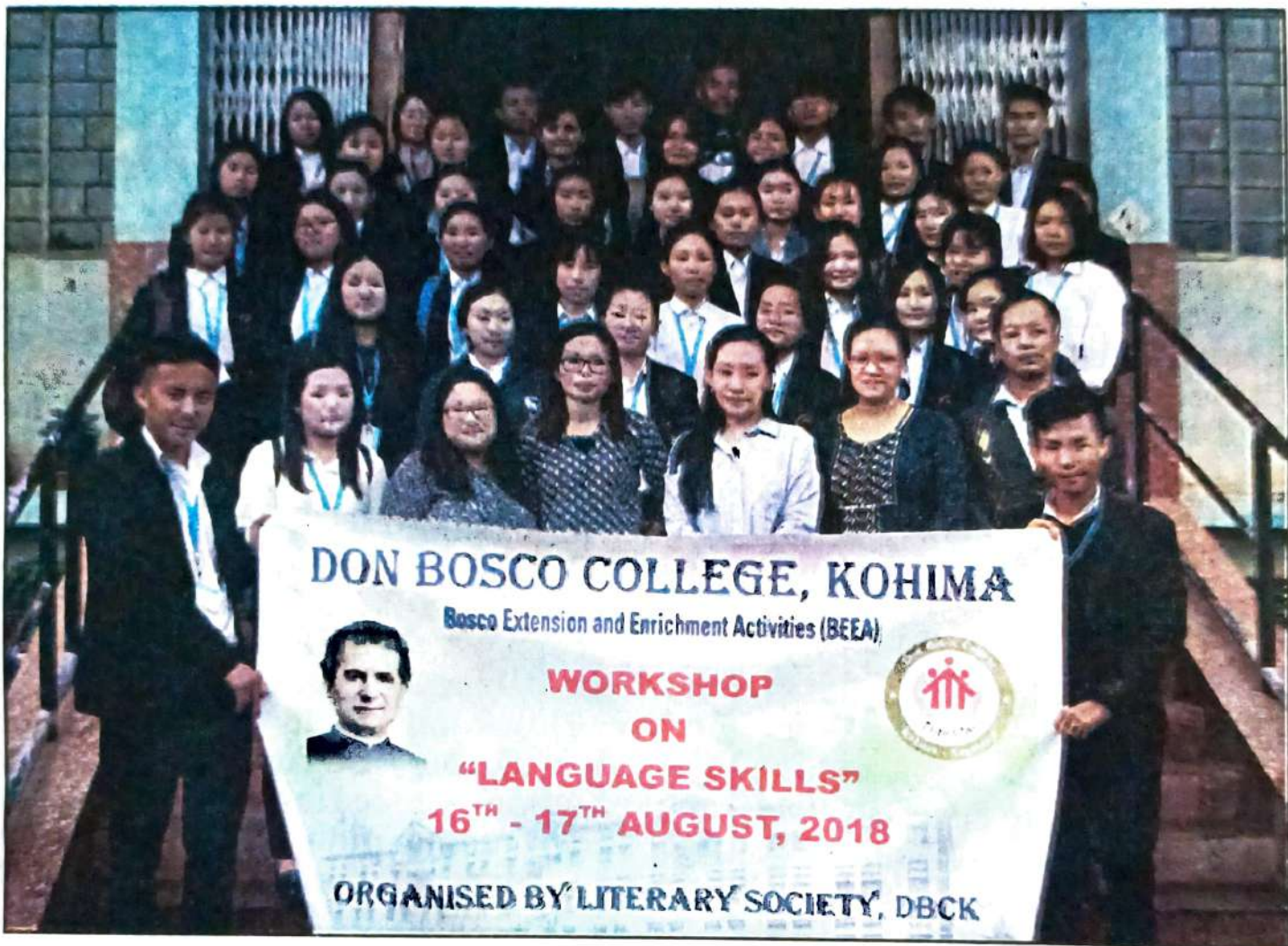
Two Day Literary Workshop on Language Skills held at DBCK

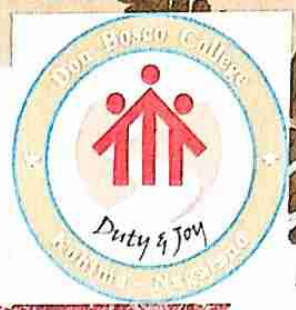
