


## REPORT ON BASIC ENGLISH GRAMMAR RULES CERTIFICATE COURSE

The Department of English, Don Bosco College Kohima has offered a certificate course on Basic Grammar Rules for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester Students from 1<sup>st</sup> August-15<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. The initiative was taken with an objective to improvise and sharpen the grammatical foundation in the students. The course has covered on the Subject-Verb Agreement, Tense, Modals, Articles, Preposition and Conjunction rules. 153 students availed the course. During the course, one formative assessment test was conducted to monitor the student progress and provide feedback for improvement. A summative assessment test is conducted for a total of 100 marks, with 40 marks as the qualifying mark. Certificates are distributed to the students who successfully completed the course and met the qualifying marks.
