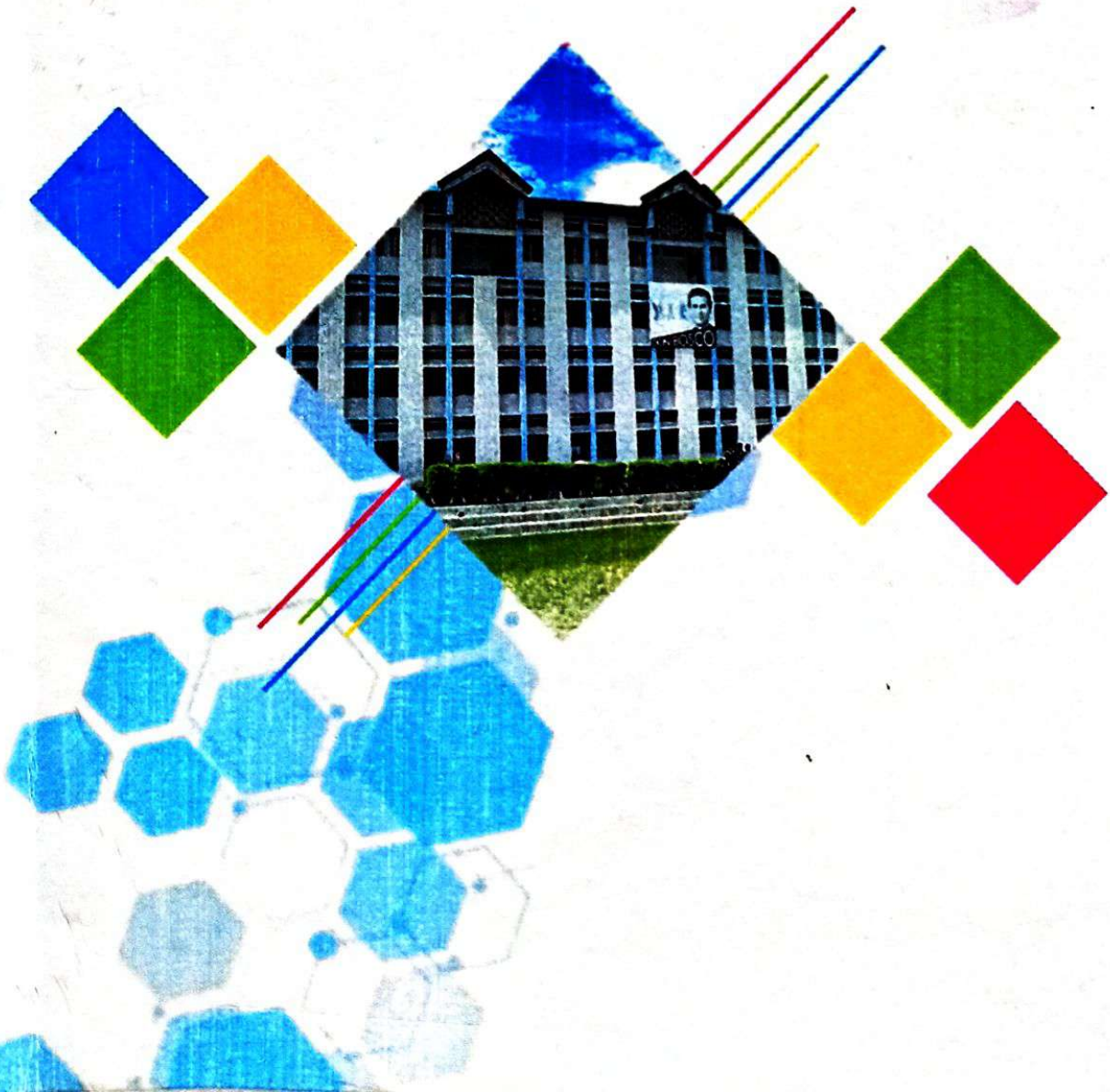



**REPORT ON NATIONAL SEMINAR “CULTURE PARADIGM-THE
PLURALISTIC NORTH EAST INDIA: APPRECIATING THE DIVERSE CULTURE
OF NORTH-EAST INDIA”**

DATE: 1ST- 2ND NOVEMBER 2019

A two day National Seminar on “*Culture Paradigm-The pluralistic North East India: Appreciating the Diverse Culture of North-East India*” was organized by the Research Cell & IQAC Don Bosco College, Kohima, Nagaland, on 1st and 2nd November, 2019.

The inaugural session was chaired by *Ms. Jarani Mao* co-convenor of the seminar. The programme started with a prayer invoked by Fr. Paul Punii, Parish Priest & Rector, CKC Kohima and welcome address was delivered by Fr. Innocent vice Principal, DBHSS & Administrator DBCK. Shri. Thepfulhouvi Solo, IFS, Former Principal Secretary, Govt. of Nagaland, graced the occasion as the special invitee. Shri. Kiremwati Former Pro Vice Chancellor, NEHU delivered the keynote address. In his keynote address, he stated that, “customs and traditions of the people of North East India are so pluralistic, and yet co-existing beautifully like beads of a garland joined together by a strong thread which must have been developed not only by geographical closeness, but more by the each-other’s love and respect in the paradigm of pluralistic culture.”

Kiremwati emphasized the present concept of one country and one language; the education reform in the country; and the looming political uncertainty should attract universities and colleges for serious fearless research. He further urged the scholars not to neglect the traditional values imbedded in the cultural ethos of Northeast. Vote of Thanks was delivered by *Dr. Lanukumla Ao*, Convenor of the seminar.

The Academic Sessions were chaired by *Prof. Tiatoshi Jamir*, Dept. of History & Archaeology, Nagaland University, *Prof. Xavier P. Mao*, Dept. of Philosophy, NEHU, Shillong, *Prof. Y. Ben Lotha* Dept. of History & Archaeology, Nagaland University. *Prof. Das*, Dept. of English, Nagaland University.

The Valedictory Session was chaired by *Dr. Imtinaro*, Co-Convenor, of the seminar. *Fr. Thomas*, Asst, Parish Priest CKC, Kohima invoked the session. The Participants also gave good insights on the seminar. Critique of the Seminar was delivered by *Prof. Das*, Dept. of English, Nagaland University. Vote of Thanks was delivered by *Dr. Velhou Koza*, Member, Organizing Committee.
