

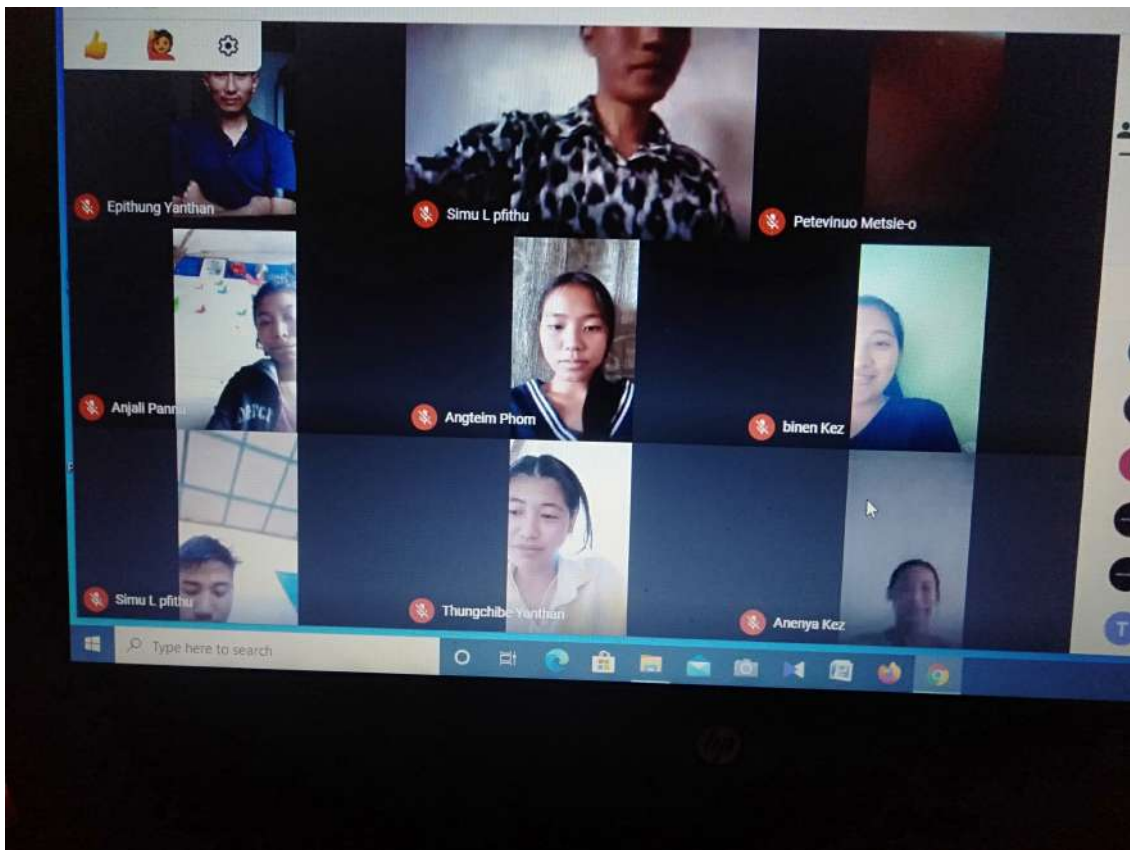

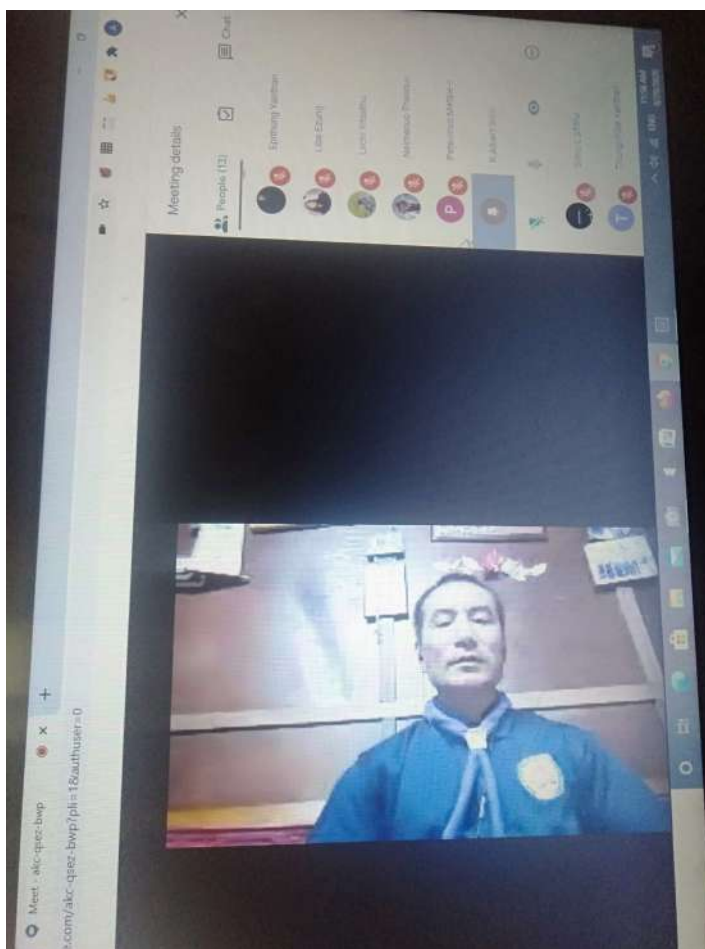


Report: Rovers & Rangers Club Activity

After the talk some students also put up questions which were clarified by the resource person. The program was a success as the members were able to gain more knowledge and also better understand the working process of the club.



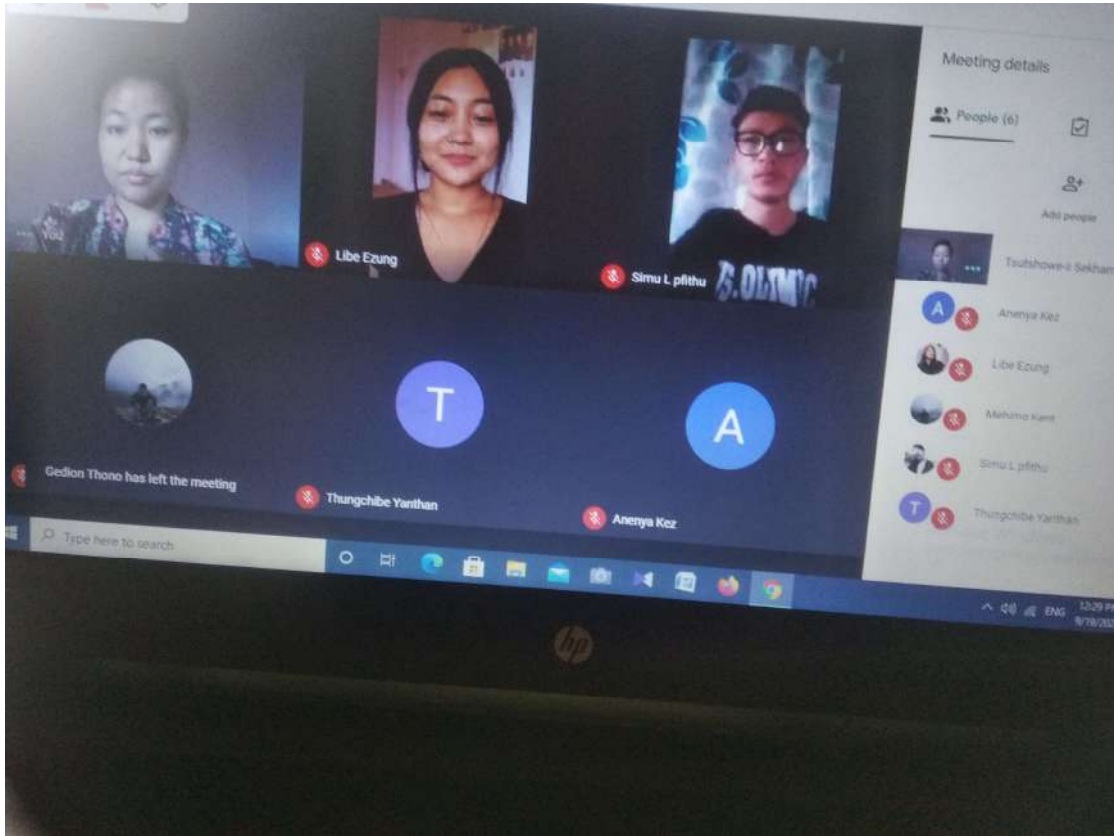
Report: Rovers & Rangers Club Activity

The second day of the mission program was with the club rovers and rangers, altogether 9 members including NSS took part.

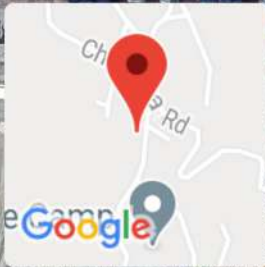
The day began with prayer and introduction of the club and their activities by Kumtsula Yimchuger.

The first event was a warm up physical exercise. The students were excited and happy.

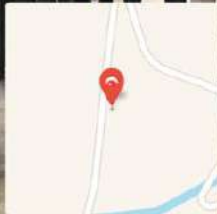
The second thing was demonstration of safety measures during the time of natural calamities. Talks were shared by the club and also demos were conducted.

TallyAce Certificate Course

22nd September 2020- Don Bosco College Kohima started its first Certificate Course on Tally signing an Institutional Partner Empanelment with Tally Education Private Limited, Kolkata on this day. The course covered all the basics of Tally known as TallyAce which consisted of 6 units and an additional 2 units included which covered GST and MIS in Tally ERP9. The duration of the course was for 6 months.

25th September 2020- The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed between Don Bosco College, Kohima and Don Bosco Higher Secondary School, Kohima for the purpose of providing IT facilities to the College in order to provide TallyAce Certificate Course and Other Computer Courses to the Students and others.


8th February 2021- Online theory classes started on this day with 1st batch of 162 students from the 4th Semester 2021. Each student was provided with their own student portal from the Tally Education Application which included E-content, tutorial videos, mock test and verifying of certificates after their final exams. The students were also given hands on classes in the Computer Lab as a part of practical classes starting from 18th February 2021.

29th April 2021- The first Internal Offline Theory Exam for Tally was held on this day successfully.

31st May to 28th June- Due to Lockdown because of Pandemic the students were allowed to give their Final Practical Exams from their home itself through Tally Online Portal. 15-20 students appeared their exams per day. The exam was monitored according to the time allotted to the students where the students were given 60 minutes for 60 questions to complete their exam which was based on Multiple Choice Questions only. 93 students successfully got through the practical online examination.

7th Aug to 24th Aug 2021- Reassessment exam was done for 16 students who wanted to appear again for the final practical out of which 10 successfully got through.


