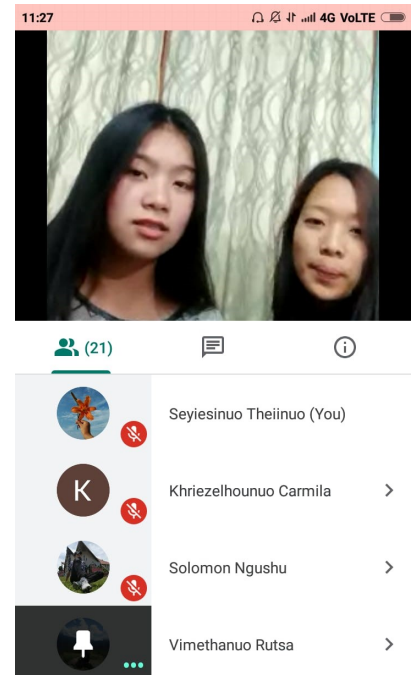


6th September 2020:

6th March 2021:

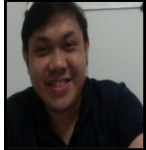
Fellowship was held on 16th march at college. We invited Brother Vinesh, full timer of JY, as the resource person. The purpose of the fellowship was to build our fellowship.

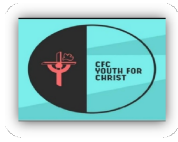

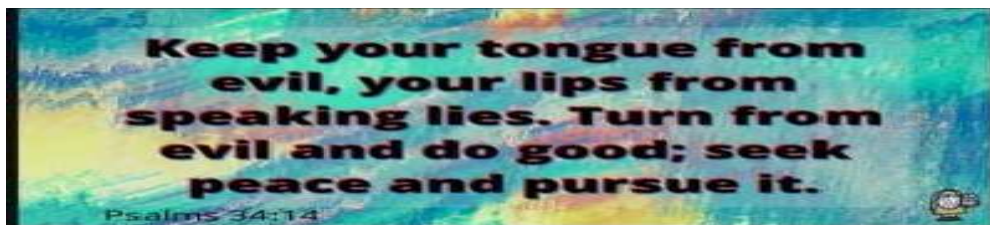
