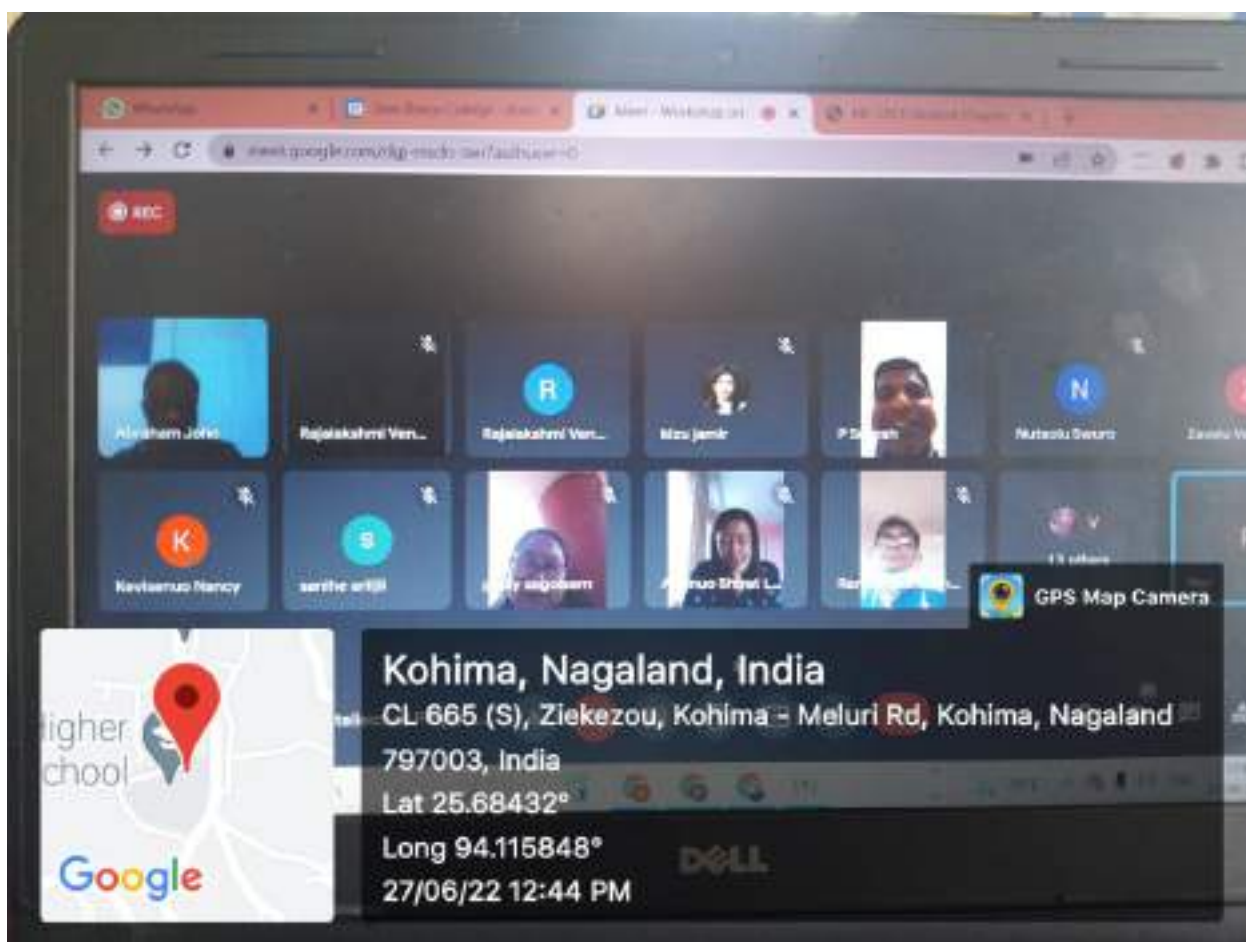

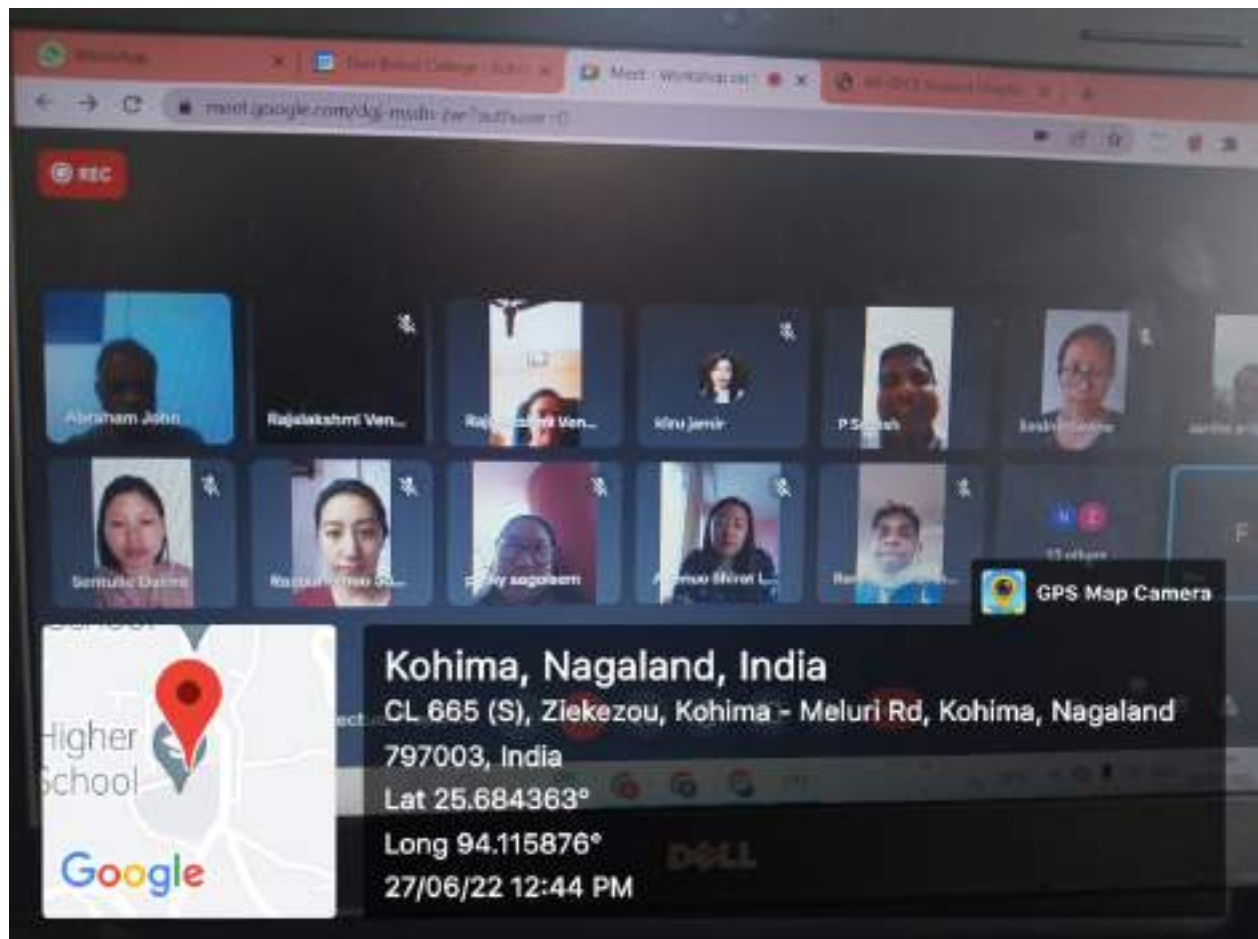
### TOPIC: Intellectual Property Right

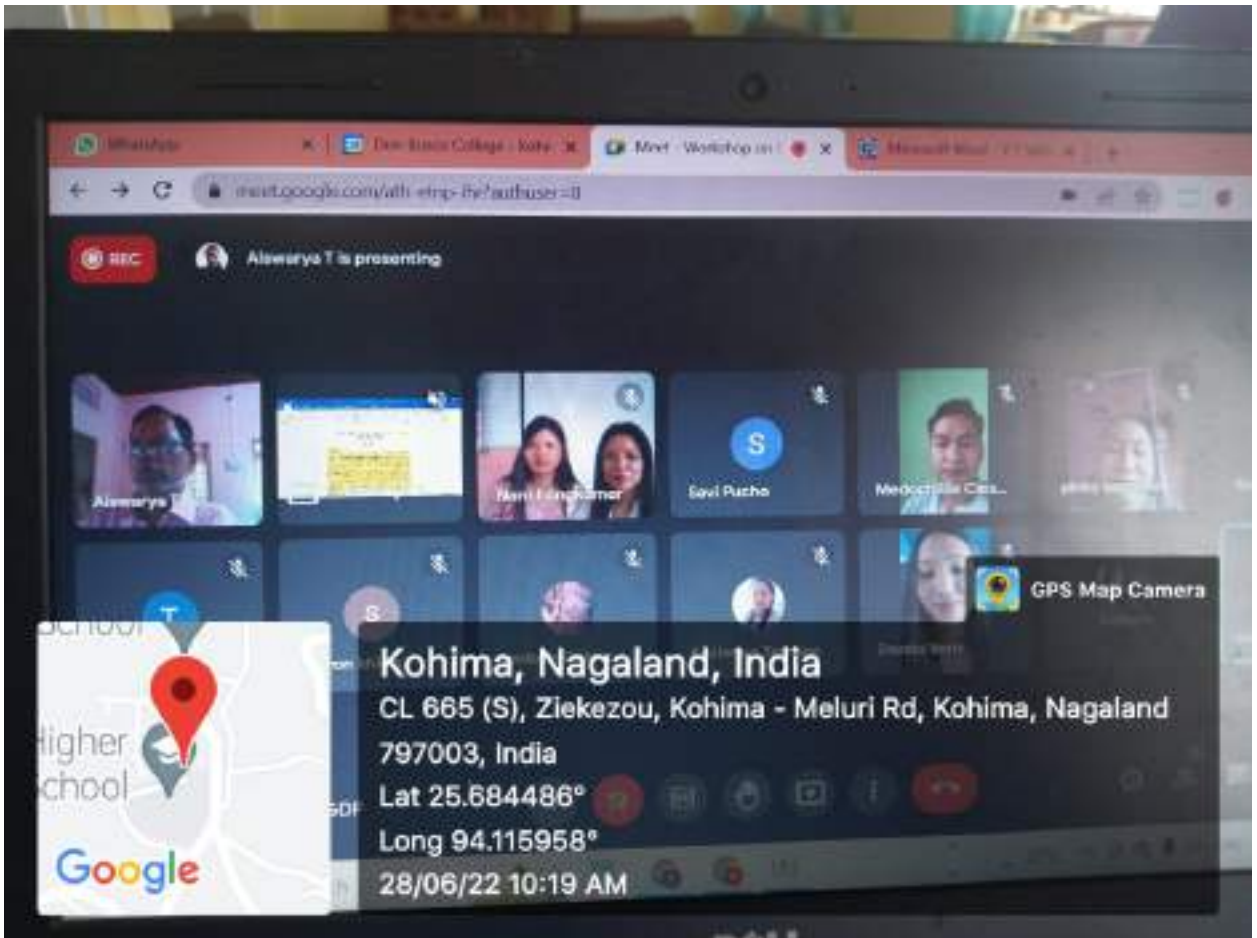



The students had a fruitful learning by involving in writing their own short stories. The workshop finally winded up with a vote of thanks by Chathasezo Charles.





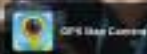

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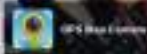

## **Report of workshop conducted by science block DBCK on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

On 19<sup>th</sup> July 2022, the science block of DBCK comprising of Department of Chemistry, Botany and Zoology organized a workshop on 'sexual harassment' for the students, faculties and the non-teaching staff of the science block. The objectives of the orientation were to sensitize the students as well as the teaching and non-teaching staff against sexual harassment at work place and campus, and to bring an awareness of the policy on these issues and the support system available at the college. 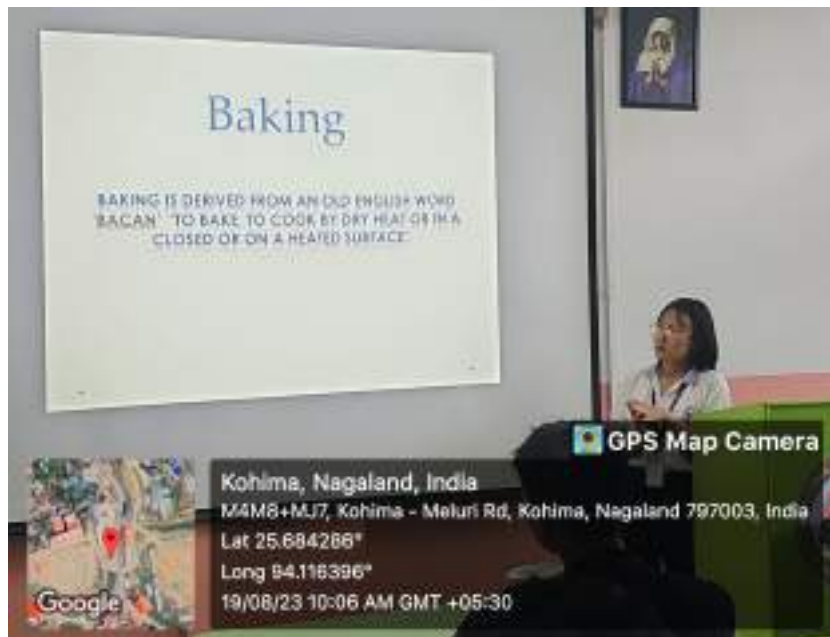
