

## Feedback on Curriculum by Student (1 Semester 2022-23)


## **Data Interpretation**


#### **Data interpretation**






#### Data interpretation






## **Data interpretation**








## **Data interpretation**




## **Data Interpretation**




#### **Data Interpretation**






## **Data Interpretation**






## **Data Interpretation**






#### **Data interpretation**






## **Data interpretation**




#### **Data Interpretation**






## **Data interpretation**




























## **Data Interpretation**




#### **Data Interpretation**






#### **Data Interpretation**










#### **Data Interpretation**




## **Data Interpretation**











## **Data Interpretation**




