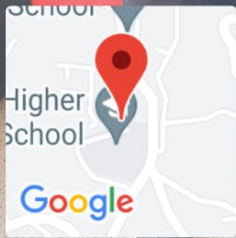


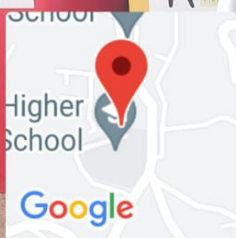
Report on signing MOU between Don Bosco College Kohima and Hulladek Recycling Private Limited
