

# WORKSHOP ON CREATIVE WRITING

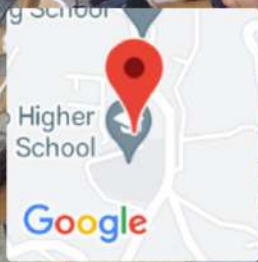

The students had a fruitful learning by involving in writing their own short stories. The workshop finally winded up with a vote of thanks by Chathasezo Charles.





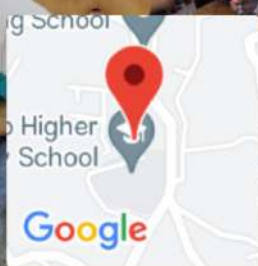

On the 19<sup>th</sup> of July, a Capacity Building Program was organised by the Department of History, DBCK at Hall T2 for guiding the students of 1st, 3rd and 5th semester students of the Department of History of Don Bosco College. The program started from 8:00 Am to 10:00 AM. The program was held to educate and give a brief enquiry on effective management of the interview process and resume writing. There was a series of studies done of the management of time in an interview. The management and introduction to it was taken by the Resource person, Miss Alovi. She is certified in Management Skills for Fresher in Career Guidance. The students were taught on interview management which included communication skills, on the leadership skills, experience, and qualification of the individual, the background and academics. The workshop consisted of the golden rules of interview process and the commonly asked questions and the ace of base which commodates on making students more confident in the future. The training workshop had the objective to showcase on the different managements. There was active participation among the students when questions or opinions were raised. The participants gave prominent answers which intrigued more on the subject and were asked to focus on specific objectives, to identify priorities, bring about certain skills in an interview.


The main objective of the workshop was to teach in advance the matters of interview management, on the confidence, conflict resolution, resourcefulness, non-verbal communication, productivity, time management, strategic storytelling, stress management, leadership, growth mindset, public speaking. It also follows up on to prepare a list of questions, maintain good eye contact. Students would be more prepared in future endeavors. The program turned out for the best since there was student's participation in huge number, the presentation carried out was subtle and clear and even online links were provided to further help the cause of students. Alongside, Miss Alovi, other teachers were present to look after the program, Miss Tsutshowe-u Sekhamo, Dr. Lanuakumla Ao, Mr. Lokho Anthony and Miss Senjano N Murry. The workshop resulted in a vast participation of individuals and gave much impetus to bring about measures while taking an interview. It ended at 10:00 AM and the students and the teachers gathered for a photo session and dispersed after taking their attendance. The Capacity Building Program was taken to build up the confidence of students while seeking for employment in the future and to receive a better outlook of themselves in it.

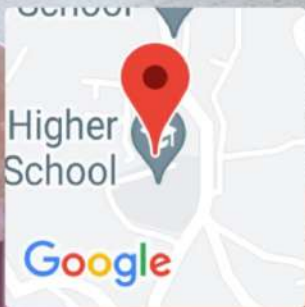

**DEBATE COMPETITION HELD BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE**

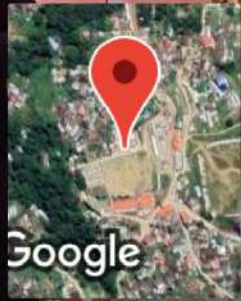

Overall the program showcased great participation from both teams and cooperation from everyone else, ending as a resounding success.



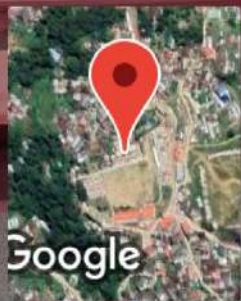
