
EUPHORIA 2021



Day 3 & 4

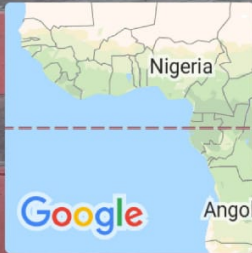

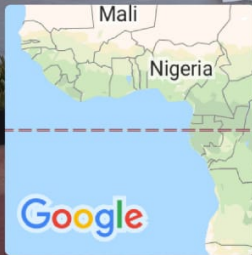

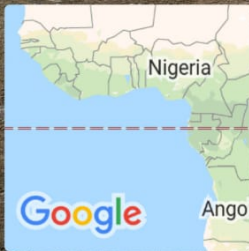

GPS Map Camera



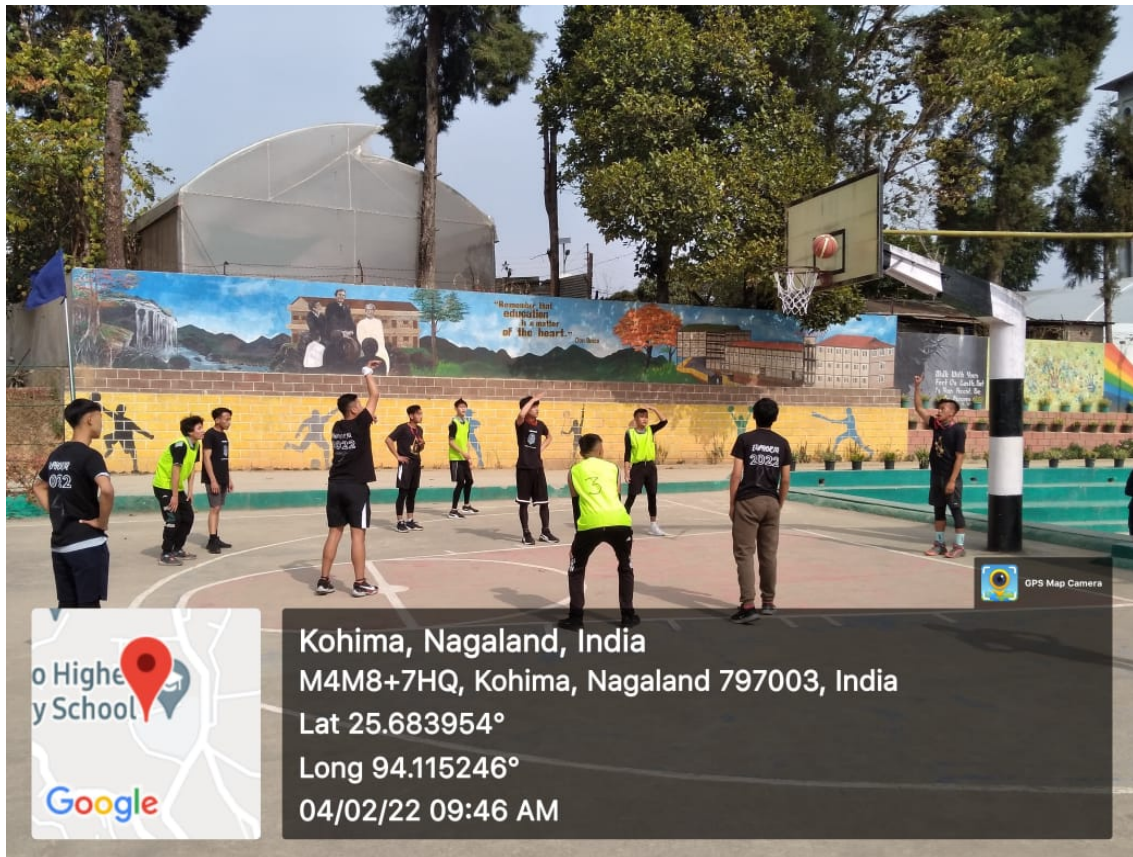

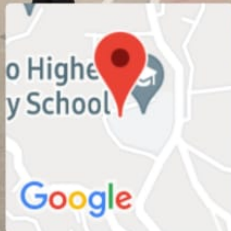
