In pursuance for higher excellence, on the 18<sup>th</sup> of May 2023, DBCK Alumni submitted its proposal to the Home Department led by Convener Asst. Prof. Imtiwapang T Longkumer by presenting its bid and proposition in the quarterly Home Department meeting to upgrade the Alumni Association into a Society.

The Alumni Association of Don Bosco College Kohima successfully navigated the requisite legal procedures, fulfilling all requirements for registration and attained official recognition as a society under the Government of Nagaland, Home Department, Societies Registration Cell. In pursuant to section 3 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and amended vide Societies Registration (Nagaland Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Amendment) Act, 2008 DBCK Alumni **registered as a Society** under the title '**DON BOSCO COLLEGE KOHIMA ALUMNI**' and numbered as HOME/SRC-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty (HOME/SRC-7720) dated: 01-06-2023.
