Report on International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women

Report on Flash Mob

On 6th December 2018, thirty (30) students from Don Bosco College Kohima performed a Flash Mob in Government High School Junction, Kohima at 2:00 P.M. The students choreographed on the song, "Salute" by "Little Mix". The purpose for the flash mob was to spread awareness on Beti Bachao Beti Parhao and violence against women in general. It was organized as part of the 16 days activism against gender based violence campaign initiated by the State Resource Center for Women, Government of Nagaland. A cash of Rs. 10,000/- was sanctioned for performing the task by the SRCW. Women Cell, DBCK coordinated the programme.

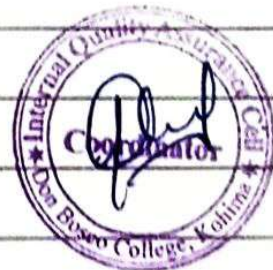
Report on Awareness programme on Mental Health
