


INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA - 2022

International Yoga Day ended with a huge success where all faculties, staffs, and participants were taught the importance of yoga in their life and how to maintain the harmony between the body and mind.









NSS Unit 7 Report on the Pre-Christmas Celebration with the Road Heroes of High School Junction, Kohima





After the screening of all films, the vote of thanks and benediction was given by the Vice-Principal of Alder College, Sir Lorhu.







Report of NSS UNIT-3 Orientation cum Cleanliness Drive on 14th August, 2023


