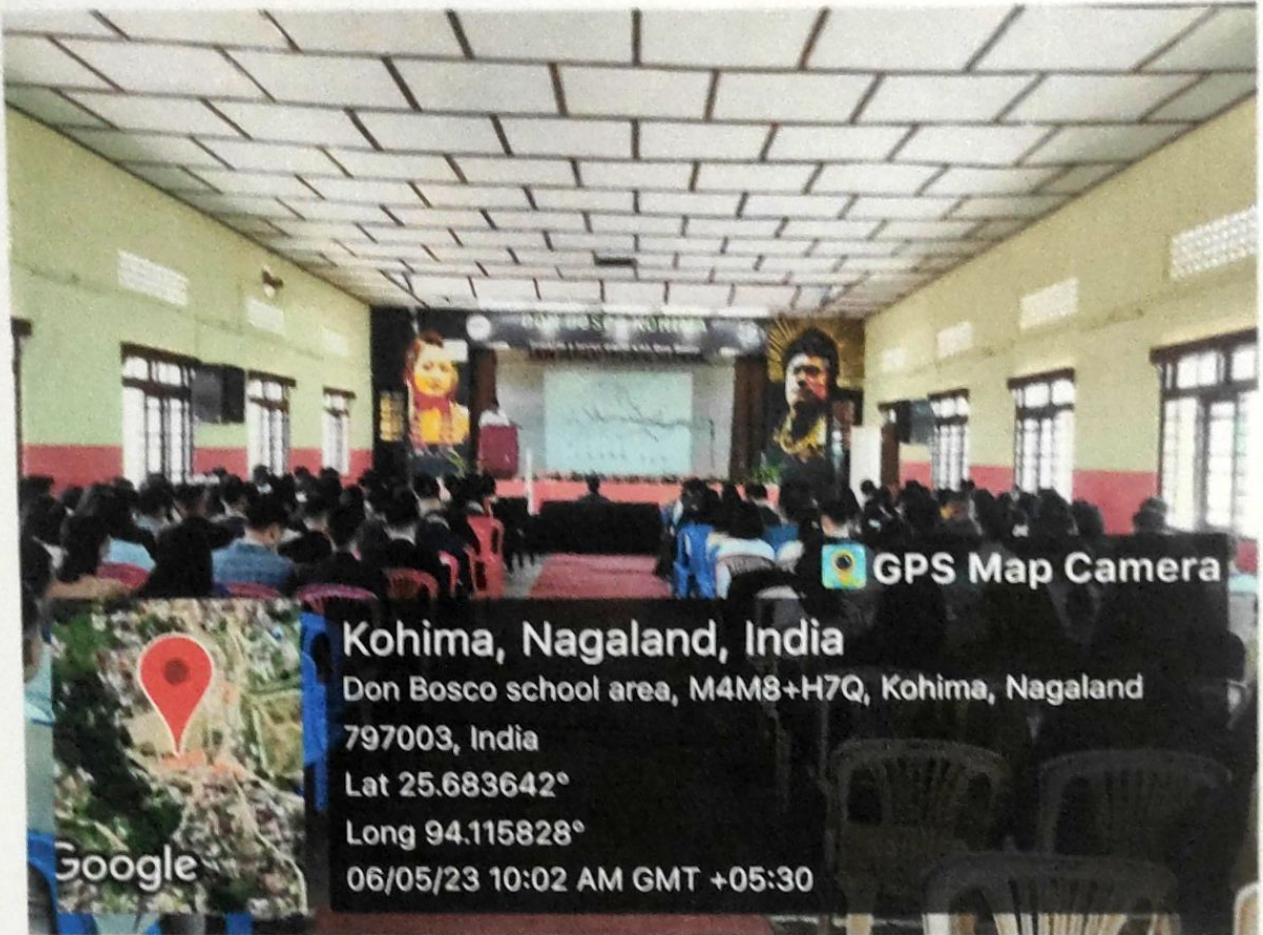

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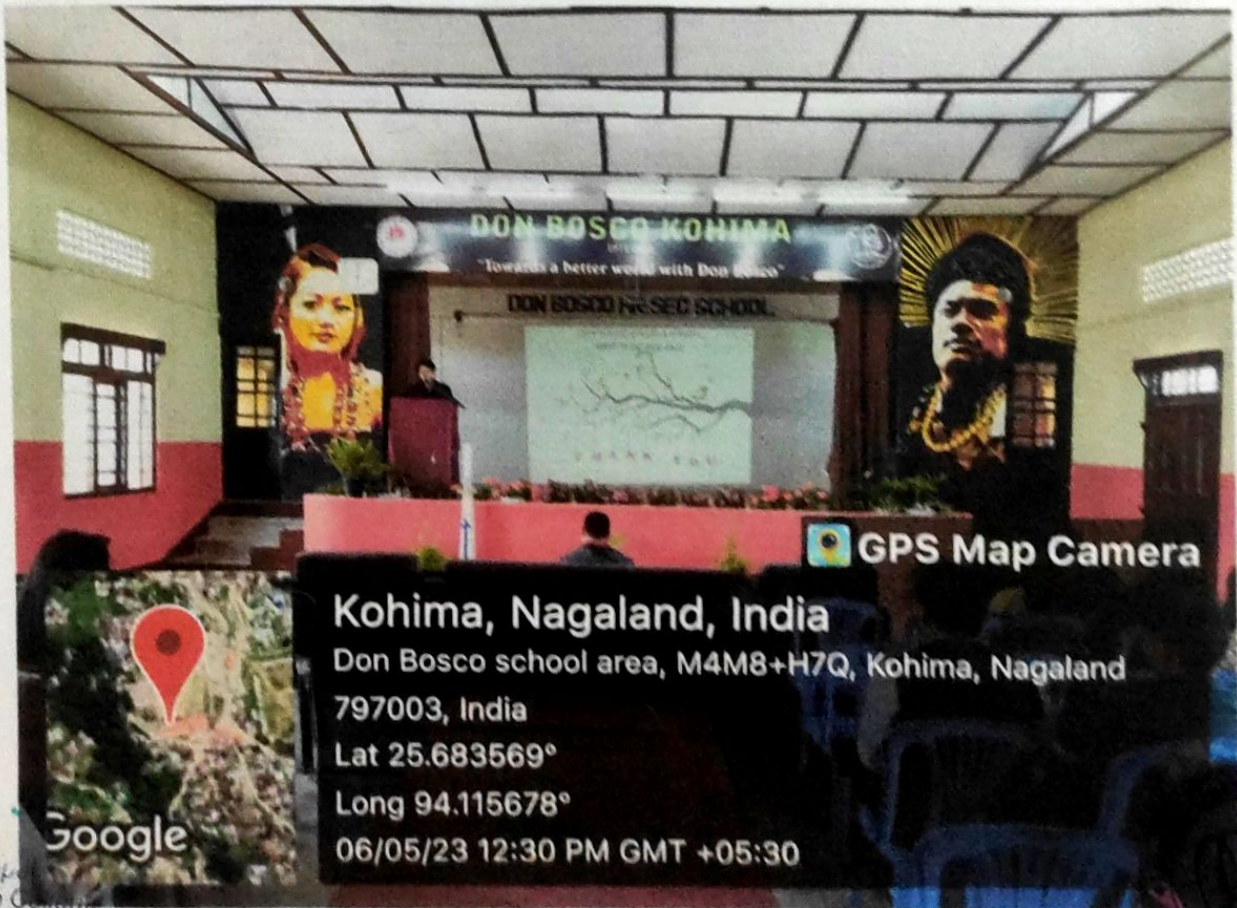

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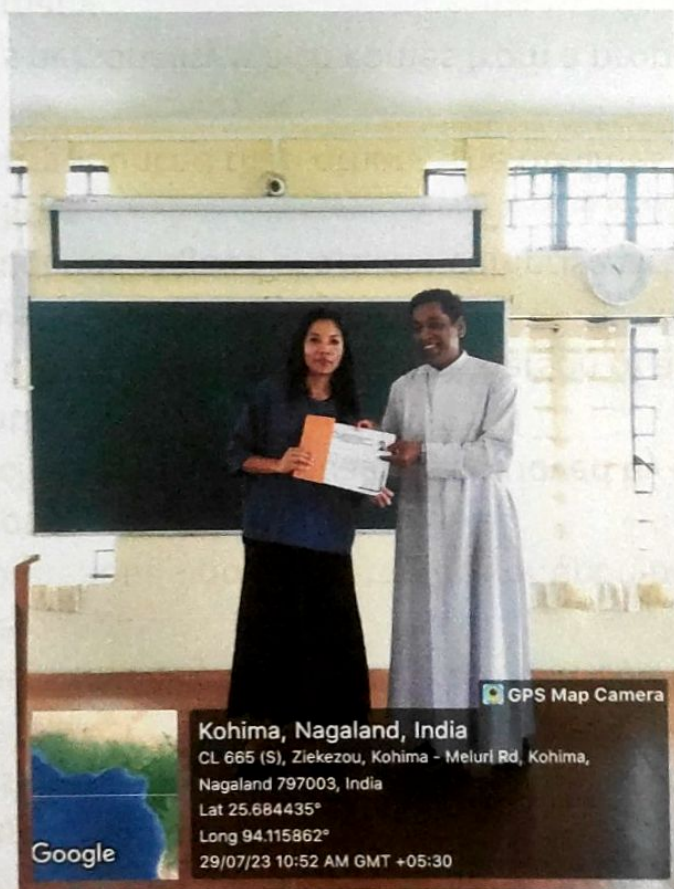
## **IQAC Meeting with the Teaching Staff and Non-Teaching Report**
