Banned 10 years ago, 26,000 rat-hole coal mines not closed yet: Meghalaya HC panel

SHILLONG, MAY 8 (PTI): The state's six abandoned rat-hole coal mines in Meghalaya's East Jaintia district have not been closed despite orders, posing risk of loss of life of humans as well as livestock. The number of rat-hole mines from other districts - West Khasi Hills, South West Khasi Hills and South Garo Hills - where coal mining is banned but not fully closed, are also yet to be notified.

Investigation into 50 cases are still pending, the police said. The Karbi continues to be not applied of the reasons for the pendency of investigations.
